Woven with Elders is specifically for community organizations that serve our Pacific Islander communities that have been devastated by COVID-19 with high rates of infection, hospitalization, and death. Our communities are strong and have faced many pandemics in the past. Vaccinations are the best way to ensure our cultural knowledge, practices, and traditions that we have learned from our elders continue on to the next generations.

We encourage you to use and share our toolkit components that will be translated into various Micronesian, Polynesian, and Melanesian languages.
